SOLE SOURCE POSTING

The Attorney General of Washington contemplates awarding a sole source contract to Thomson Reuters to provide a subscription to the electronic database known as WestlawNext.

Thomson Reuters is the only vendor which provides electronic access to the product known as Washington Practice, which is included in WestlawNext. This title is a set of annotated law treatises which covers various subject areas related to the practice of law specific to Washington State. This is widely used by the office and is considered an essential resource.

The contract will be issued on or about August 1, 2015 for 36 months with an option for extension. The dollar value is estimated at \$725,000.

Offerors contemplating the above requirements are required to submit capability statements detailing their ability to meet the state's requirements within five (5) calendar days of this announcement. The following information should be included in the capability statements:
