

1 1. Defendants violated the Consent Decree by providing legal immigration-related
2 services in violation of the injunctions, and by their conduct have demonstrated a
3 cognizable danger of recurrent violations, therefore Defendants are permanently
4 enjoined from further providing any immigration-related services in any capacity,
5 including providing clerical services related to immigration matters, whether on their
6 own or as employees of another.

7 2. Defendants shall pay to the State \$35,000 in civil penalties pursuant to RCW
8 19.86.140 that were previously suspended on condition of compliance with the Consent
9 Decree.

10 3. In addition to unsuspended civil penalties of \$35,000, Defendants Edwin Cruz
11 and Maurice Terry each shall pay to the State \$25,000. The Court imposes this penalty
12 based on its finding that Defendants violated the Consent Decree.

13 4. Restitution of \$148,774 shall be paid to the State of Washington to be returned
14 to consumers that were harmed by Defendants engaging in unauthorized practice of
15 immigration law and providing immigration-related services. If the State is unable to
16 locate consumers entitled to restitution, the State is hereby authorized to use any
17 remaining portion of said restitution for any lawful purpose, at the sole discretion of the
18 Attorney General.

19 5. Defendants shall also pay to the State its reasonable costs and fees in the
20 amount of \$122,675.00.




1 6. These amounts shall be paid to the State of Washington by check made payable

4 Avenue, Suite 2000, Seattle, Washington 98104-3188.




