**ORDER AFFIRMING THE  
EXISTENCE OF PROBABLE  
CAUSE AND DIRECTING THE  
CUSTODIAL DETENTION OF  
RESPONDENT**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on October 30, 2020, on the petitioner's motion for an order affirming this Court's previous finding of probable cause to believe Respondent is a sexually violent predator. In addition, the State has moved this Court for an order directing the custodial detention of Respondent. At the hearing on these matters, the State was represented by Assistant Attorney General Rose McGillis. Respondent was present via telephone and was represented by counsel, Sonja Hardenbrook.

In determining these matters, the Court considered the pleadings submitted by the parties, any evidence presented at hearing, and the argument of counsel. Based upon all of this, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. There is probable cause to believe Respondent is Gary Lee Clark.
2. There is probable cause to believe Respondent is a sexually violent predator.
3. Pursuant to RCW 71.09.040(4), Respondent shall remain at the Special Commitment Center on McNeil Island and be held there until further order of this Court.
