Out of an abundance of caution, and in compliance with Washington law, we are writing to inform of a recent data security incident that may have exposed personal information including your name and full date of birth to an unauthorized third party.

While we do not believe that this incident poses a risk of harm to you, we are sharing this information out of an abundance of caution.

On April 7, 2025, we were made aware that a third-party likely accessed our stored data on April 2, 2025. We immediately took action to protect your data by employing a leading forensic IT firm to resecure our systems and investigate the extent of the data exposure. We are working in conjunction with the firm to deploy cybersecurity best practices and apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

Again, we are confident that the Washington personal information exposed to third parties is limited only to your name and birth date. We do not believe that any payment information was compromised. However, out of an abundance of caution, and in compliance with Washington law, we are sharing the below information for major credit reporting agencies.
