Re: Cyber Incident

Dear Teamster,

We are writing to inform you of a recent cyber incident that potentially involved unauthorized access to your personal information held by Teamsters Local Union No. 117 ("Local 117"). We regret that this incident occurred and take the security of your personal information seriously.

What Happened?

On June 16, 2025, Local 117 became aware of a cyber incident that disrupted certain computer systems. Through our investigation, we determined an unauthorized third party gained access to files stored on our server.

What Are We Doing?

Upon discovery of this issue, Local 117 immediately took steps to secure its systems and engaged with experts to assist in the investigation and remediation of this incident. Additionally, please rest assured that Local 117 has taken prompt action to ensure the security of our network including investing in new and improved hardware systems, enhancing our security and monitoring protocols, and generally working to improve all facets of our cyber security moving forward.

What Information May Have Been Accessed?

The information potentially impacted by this incident includes names, dates of birth and social security numbers.

What You Can Do.

Local 117 encourages you to remain vigilant against incidents of identity theft and fraud by reviewing your account statements and monitoring your free credit reports for suspicious activity. Additionally, you can contact any of the three major credit bureaus to place a fraud alert or credit freeze on your credit file:
