THIS MATTER came for hearing before the Court on February 21, 2020, on Plaintiff State of Washington's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment. The State appeared through its counsel, ERIC S. NEWMAN, Chief Litigation Counsel – Antitrust Division; Defendants Tim Eyman and Tim Eyman, Watchdog for Taxpayers LLC appeared through counsel. The Court considered the records and pleadings in this case, including but not limited to this Court's order on non-monetary sanctions (dated September 13, 2019), the parties' briefing on this motion and the parties' oral argument. Being fully informed, now, therefore, the Court

ORDERS as follows:

1. Plaintiff State of Washington's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment is

**GRANTED.**

2. ~~Defendant Eyman concedes that he~~ *Mr. Eyman* solicits contributions to compensate himself

1 for promoting anti-tax ballot propositions. The Court finds this undisputed fact establishes that  
2 Defendant Eyman has an expectation of receiving funds toward electoral goals, which requires  
3 reporting under the Fair Campaign Practices Act.

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5 3. This Court hereby finds that Defendant Eyman is a “continuing political  
6 committee,” as that term is defined by RCW 42.17A.005;


7 4. This Court hereby finds that Defendant Eyman failed to register as a political  
8 committee, and as of the date of this order, his registration is at least 2,706 days late;

9 5. This Court hereby finds that Defendant Eyman, as a political committee, failed  
10 to report \$766,447 in contributions he received, which were found to have been in support of  
11 ballot propositions by order of this Court dated September 13, 2019, in violation of the Fair  
12 Campaign Practices Act;

13  
14 6. This Court hereby finds that Defendant Eyman was required to file one C-3 report  
15 and one C-4 report for each of 55 separate months during the period September 2012 through  
16 July 2018, and the combined 110 reports are a combined 173,862 days late as of the date of this  
17 order;

18 7. This Court hereby finds that Defendant Eyman concealed \$766,447 in  
19 contributions, which were found to have been in support of ballot propositions by order of this  
20 Court dated September 13, 2019, in violation of RCW 42.17A.435.
