II. ORDER

This matter came before the Court on the State of Washington's Motion for Entry of Default Judgment. The Court examined the papers and pleadings on file in this case, including the Order of Default, before entering the Judgment herein.

Based on the pleadings and evidence presented, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Default Judgment is granted. The Order is entered as follows:

III. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 3.1 Defendant EMFA LLC dba EM Fine Art ("EMFA") is a Washington limited liability company. Its principal place of business was, at all times relevant to this action, 410 Dexter Ave. N. Seattle, WA, 98109.
- 3.2 Defendant Roland Crane is a managing member of EMFA who participated in and controlled the policies, procedures, acts, and practices of EMFA. Roland Crane resided in King County at all times relevant to this action.
- 3.3 Defendant Amanda Crane is a managing member of EMFA who participated in and controlled the policies, procedures, acts and practices of EMFA. Amanda Crane resided in King County at all times relevant to this action.
- 3.4 Defendants sold reservations of a venue known as the EM Fine Art Gallery ("the Gallery") at 410 Dexter Ave N, Seattle WA 98109 for weddings and other events. Defendants accepted down payments from consumers and promised, in return, to provide them access to the Gallery.
- 3.5 Defendants misrepresented their ability to provide consumers access to the Gallery by selling reservations that they knew could not be fulfilled. Defendants knew by at least April 18, 2014 that they would be unable to provide consumers access to the Gallery after May 2014. Despite this knowledge, Defendants solicited and accepted payments from

- consumers between April 18, 2014 and June 6, 2014 for Gallery reservations scheduled to be fulfilled after May 2014.
- 3.6 Defendants systematically failed to provide consumers access to the Gallery as promised. Dozens of consumers paid Defendants for reservations scheduled to be fulfilled after May 2014, but Defendants stopped fulfilling reservations after May 21, 2014.
- 3.7 Defendants refused to provide refunds for Gallery reservations that they failed to fulfill. Instead, Defendants converted consumers' payments and currently owe consumers at least \$50,000 for undelivered venue rental services.
- 3.8 Defendants also misrepresented the facts and circumstances concerning their failure to deliver. In an attempt to explain why they could not fulfill reservations or provide refunds, Roland Crane and Amanda Crane sent two mass emails to customers in June, 2014. The first email falsely claimed that an electrical fire had destroyed the Gallery. The second email falsely claimed that Defendants had been blindsided by their landlords.
- 3.9 Defendants' conduct affects the public interest because it involved purchases made by dozens of Washington consumers.

IV. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 4.1 The Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this action and over the parties hereto, and Plaintiff's Complaint states claims upon which relief may be granted.
- 4.2 The Attorney General has authority to bring this action pursuant to RCW 19.86.080.
- 4.3 Defendants' conduct described in Findings of Fact 3.1 through 3.9 is unfair or deceptive because it has the capacity to mislead a substantial number of Washington consumers.

- 5.3 Pursuant to RCW 19.86.080, Defendants are ordered to pay restitution to aggrieved consumers in the amount of \$50,000.00.
- 5.4 Pursuant to RCW 19.86.080, Defendants are ordered to pay Plaintiff, State of Washington, its costs and reasonable attorneys' fees for this action in the amount of \$18,994.51
- 5.5 Pursuant to RCW 19.86.140, Defendants are ordered to pay Plaintiff, State of Washington, a civil penalty of \$236,000.00, representing 236 violations of RCW 19.86.020, provided that if additional consumers are identified within 18 months of the entry of this Judgment as being subject to Defendants' unfair and deceptive practices, Plaintiff may, at its discretion, award restitution to those consumers from the sum received as a civil penalty pursuant to the Court's award herein.
- 5.6 The amounts payable pursuant to paragraphs 5.2, 5.3 and 5.4 must be paid in full within six months of the entry of this judgment and must be made in the form of a cashier's check or checks drawn to the order of the State of Washington.
- 5.7 Nothing in this Judgment may be construed as to limit or bar any other governmental entity or any consumer in the pursuit of other remedies against Defendants.
- 5.8 Representatives of the Office of Attorney General are permitted, upon reasonable notice to Defendants, to access and inspect all business records or documents under the control of Defendants to monitor compliance with the terms of this Judgment.
- 5.9 Pursuant to RCW 19.86.140, any violation of the terms of this Judgment will form the basis for further enforcement proceedings, including, but not limited to, contempt of Court proceedings and forfeiture of the civil penalty of up to Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) for violations committed after the date of this Judgment.
- 5.10 The violation of any of the injunctive terms of this Judgment will constitute a violation of RCW 19.86.020.

2	for further restitution and for the enforcement of compliance with the terms of this Judgment.
