PETITION

COMES NOW Petitioner, State of Washington, by and through ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and JAMES BUDER, Assistant Attorney General, and submits this petition seeking the involuntary civil commitment of Respondent, BRIAN TAYLOR-ROSE, as a sexually violent predator pursuant to chapter 71.09 RCW. Specifically, Petitioner alleges Respondent is a sexually violent predator, as that term is defined in RCW 71.09.020(18), given the following:

1. Respondent has been convicted of a sexually violent offense, as that term is defined in RCW 71.09.020(17). Specifically, on or about February 6, 1998, in Clallam County Superior Court, Cause No. 97-1-00263-9, Respondent was convicted of Child Molestation in the Second Degree, in violation of RCW 9A.44.086.

2. Respondent currently suffers from a mental abnormality and/or personality disorder, as those terms are defined in RCW 71.09.020.

3. Respondent's mental abnormality and/or personality disorder causes him to have serious difficulty controlling his dangerous behavior and makes him likely to engage in predatory acts of sexual violence unless confined to a secure facility.



1 4. Respondent is currently incarcerated for Child Molestation in the Third Degree,  
2 Clallam County Cause No. 09-1-00191-9, which constitutes a recent overt act as defined by  
3 RCW 71.09.020(12).

4 Based upon the foregoing, Respondent should be committed to the custody of the  
5 Department of Social and Health Services for placement in a secure facility for control, care, and  
6 treatment until such time as his condition has so changed that he no longer meets the definition of  
7 a sexually violent predator, or conditional release to a less restrictive alternative is in his best  
8 interests and conditions can be imposed that would adequately protect the community.
