

ORDER DISMISSING
PETITIONS

In a series of personal restraint petitions brought under various judgments and sentences, James Ferrell seeks relief in the form of modifications to his Department of Corrections trust account statement as it pertains to his legal financial obligations and other obligations. But he does not show that he is under unlawful restraint or that he is entitled to modifications of his trust account statement. Therefore, Ferrell's petitions must be dismissed as frivolous. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that Ferrell's petitions are dismissed under RAP 16.11(b). His request for appointment of counsel is denied.
