Re: Follow-up to Incident Notification

Dear Sir or Madam:

We are writing on behalf of our client, Vimly Benefits Solutions (Vimly), in follow up to our December 19, 2019 notice of a security incident involving Washington residents. As stated in that correspondence, Vimly's investigation and review of the member information that was actually contained in the email accounts was ongoing. The forensic investigation later confirmed there was **no acquisition** of any Vimly data, as such this notice is being provided to your office as a courtesy and follow up to our prior communications.
