Dear Governor Inslee:

We are in receipt of your letter dated September 21, 2020 requesting extension of the statutory waivers and suspensions ordered in Proclamations 20-15, 20-20, 20-21, 20-23, 20-28, 20-29, 20-30, 20-31, 20-32, 20-36, 20-41, 20-43, 20-44, 20-45, 20-48, 20-49, 20-51, 20-52, 20-56, 20-58, 20-59, 20-63, 20-64, 20-65, 20-66, 20-69 and 20-71.

By previous letter we extended Proclamation 20-69. Senator Billig and Speaker Jinkins support extending Proclamation 20-71 but Senator Schoesler and Representative Wilcox do not. As RCW 43.06.220(4) requires the agreement of all four caucus leaders, this request for extension is denied.

Senator Billig and Speaker Jinkins support extending the remaining proclamations until December 1 as requested but Senator Schoesler and Representative Wilcox support shorter extensions. As RCW 43.06.220(4) requires the agreement of all four caucus leaders, we hereby extend the statutory waivers and suspensions in Proclamations 20-15, 20-20, 20-21, 20-23, 20-28, 20-29, 20-30, 20-31, 20-32, 20-36, 20-41, 20-43, 20-44, 20-45, 20-48, 20-49, 20-51, 20-52, 20-56, 20-58, 20-59, 20-63, 20-64, 20-65 and 20-66 until 11:59 p.m. November 9, 2020.
