

ASSURANCE OF DISCONTINUANCE

The State of Washington, by and through its attorneys, Robert M. McKenna, Attorney General, and Katherine M. Tassi, Assistant Attorney General, files this Assurance of Discontinuance pursuant to RCW 19.86.100.

## I. INVESTIGATION

- 1.1 The Attorney General initiated an investigation into the business activities of the Respondent, Rommel Balingit ("Respondent").
- 1.2 In 2004, the Respondent created the Web site www.russellassetts.com. The Web site falsely purported to belong to a Washington state financial services and management company with a world-wide reputation. The Web site solicited personally identifiable information from consumers. The Web site was operational until December of 2007.
- 1.3 The Attorney General believes that the creation and operation of a Web site falsely purporting to belong to an actual financial services company has the capacity to deceive a substantial number of consumers and is therefore a deceptive and misleading practice in violation of the Consumer Protection Act, RCW 19.86 et seq.

- 1.4 The Attorney General also believes that soliciting consumers to provide personally identifying information by means of a Web site purporting to belong to a financial services company, when, in fact, it does not, is a violation of RCW 19.190.080, a section of the Commercial Electronic Mail Act.
- 1.5 Respondent denies having committed any violation of the law, including, but not limited to, RCW 19.86.020 and RCW 19.190.080.

## II. ASSURANCE OF DISCONTINUANCE

- 2.1 Although Respondent denies having engaged in any violation of law, Respondent agrees to conduct his business as follows:
- 2.2 Respondent shall not create, own, or operate any Web site falsely purporting to belong to an entity or person to which it does not belong.
- 2.3 Respondent shall not solicit or collect any personally identifiable information from consumers under false pretenses on any Web site or by any other means.

#### III. PAYMENT

3.1 The Respondent agrees to pay the amount of \$10,000.00 for the Attorney General's Office to use toward any purpose authorized pursuant to RCW 19.86.080. This amount is suspended on condition of full compliance with this Assurance.

#### IV. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

4.1 This Assurance of Discontinuance shall not be considered an admission of violation of the Consumer Protection Act, RCW 19.86, et seq., or any other statute, for any purposes, but failure to comply with this Assurance of Discontinuance shall be prima facie evidence of violations of RCW 19.86.020, thereby placing upon the violator, Respondent, the burden of defending against imposition by the Court of damages, injunctions, restitution, and civil penalties and costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees, including the costs and
