Dear Mr. Bradley and Mr. Connell:

On March 2, 2016, Mr. Bradley filed a complaint against Meridian Village Mobile Home Park (Meridian Village) with the Manufactured Housing Dispute Resolution Program (the Program) alleging that Meridian Village towed his vehicle without notice. The Program contacted Meridian Village in an attempt to facilitate negotiation between the parties and resolve the dispute through an informal dispute resolution process. However, the parties were not able to negotiate a resolution. The Program, therefore, concluded that an agreement could not be reached and informed the parties it would conduct a formal investigation. Before the investigation was initiated Mr. Bradley moved out of Meridian Village. Therefore, the Program will not be issuing a Notice of Non-Violation or a Notice of Violation. The Program will close the complaint.

We appreciate your cooperation with the Program. This matter is now closed.
