RE: Administrative Closure of Glen and Beverly Ouellette's Complaint against Washington Land Yacht Harbor MHDRP Complaint No. 458068

Dear Mr. and Ms. Ouellette and Mr. Plympton:

On December 3, 2014, Mr. and Ms. Ouellette filed a complaint against Washington Land Yacht Harbor (WLYH) with the Manufactured Housing Dispute Resolution Program (the Program) alleging that WLYH was charging an improper fee. The Program contacted WLYH in an attempt to facilitate negotiation between the parties and resolve the dispute through an informal dispute resolution process. However, the parties were not able to negotiate a resolution. The Program, therefore, concluded that an agreement could not be reached and informed the parties it would conduct a formal investigation.

Following a review of the evidence the Program does not see a dispute that would fall within the Manufactured/Mobile Home Landlord-Tenant Act. Therefore, the Program will not be issuing a Notice of Non-Violation or a Notice of Violation. The Program will close the complaint.

We appreciate your cooperation with the Program. This matter is now closed.
