Allah challenges the judgments and sentences entered in King County Superior Court Nos. 01-1-09176-6 SEA, 01-1-10807-3 SEA, and 02-1-02047-6 SEA, seeking release from confinement. Although the precise nature of his claim is by no means clear, Allah's petition and subsequently filed motions suffer the same infirmities as the elaborate legal mythologies advanced by other anti-government litigants who claim immunity from the laws of the states and United States based on such issues as the State's alleged misuse of lower or uppercase letters or punctuation in spelling the defendant's name. See, e.g. Capaldi v. Pontesso, 135 F.3d 1122 (6th Cir. 1998); United States v. Collins, 920 F.2d 619, 629-30 (10th Cir. 1990); United States v. Mundt, 29 F.3d 233, 237 (6th Cir. 1994); United States v. Mitchell, 405 F. Supp.2d 602 (D. Md. 2005); United States v. Stinson, 386 F.Supp. 2d 1207 (W.D. Okla. 2005). And this court has previously rejected numerous variations of such claims in prior personal restraint petitions filed by Allah. See Nos. 72680-3-1, 68088-9-1, 67187-1-1, 64795-4-1, 64775-0-1, 63315-5-1, 63775-4-1, 61810-5-1, 61787-7-1, 60196-2-1, 58694-7-1, 56251-7-1, 56180-4-1, 54340-7-1. He is barred from raising the issues again in a successive petition. RCW 10.73.140; In re Pers. Restraint of Haverty, 101 Wn.2d 498, 502-03, 681 P.2d 835 (1984). Moreover, Allah's conclusory allegations are not sufficient, by

themselves, to warrant relief in a personal restraint proceeding. See In re Pers.


Restraint of Rice, 118 Wn.2d 876, 886, 828 P.2d 1086 (1992).

Under the circumstances, Allah has failed to demonstrate that he is currently being restrained unlawfully.

Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that the personal restraint petition is dismissed under RAP 16.11(b).
