ORDER

This matter comes before the court on the Report and Recommendation (“R&R”) (Dkt. # 16) of the Honorable Brian A. Tsuchida, United States Magistrate Judge. The court construes a document that Plaintiff entitled “Refuse for Fraud And a Lie Brian A. Tsuchida’s Report and Recommendation Which Is Done In Bad Faith With Malice” as an objection to the R&R. Dkt. # 17.

The court concurs in the R&R, and finds that the amended complaint that Plaintiff submitted after the R&R issued does not cure any of the deficiencies that the R&R identifies.

The court ADOPTS the R&R and DENIES Plaintiff’s objection. The court dismisses this case with prejudice, finding that it is frivolous or malicious, fails to state a claim for relief, and names only defendants who are immune from suit. 28 U.S.C
