Michael Canty seeks relief from personal restraint imposed following his 2001 convictions for indecent liberties, first degree burglary and second degree robbery. He argued that the Department of Corrections wrongfully rejected his proposed release address. But on August 7, 2016, Canty reached his maximum sentence expiration date and he was transferred to the Department of Social and Health Services to await his sexually violent predator trial. Because he is no longer in the custody of the Department of Corrections, there is no relief that this court can provide, making Canty's petition moot.

Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that Canty's petition is dismissed under RAP 16.11(b).
