On January 2, 2003, plaintiff filed a civil rights claim against the Jefferson County Jail, contending that he was held by the jail for 55 days after charges against him were dismissed on January 17, 1996 Dkt 4 Defendant appeared and filed a motion to dismiss for failure to state a claim, arguing that this action is barred by the three year statute of limitations applicable to actions under 42 U S C § 1983, that plaintiff failed to file a claim pursuant to RCW 4 96 before commencing this lawsuit, and that the Jefferson County Jail is not a proper defendant Dkt 13 On May 13, 2003, US Magistrate Judge J Kelley Arnold issued a Report and Recommendation, recommending that defendant's motion to dismiss be granted and that this case be dismissed as barred by the statute of limitations Dkt 17 Plaintiff did not file objections to the Report and Recommendation.

The court has reviewed the Report and Recommendation and the remainder of the record, and concurs with the conclusion of Judge Arnold Defendant's motion to dismiss for failure to state a claim should be granted, and the case should be dismissed pursuant to 28 U S C § 1915(e)(2)(B) as frivolous
