Plaintiff 19 filed an amended complaint which was still deficient. Plaintiff set forth no facts regarding the alleged 20 actions of the named defendants and how they personally participated in preventing him from 21

meeting a court deadline. Also, there was no designation of present place of confinement, availability or completion of a grievance procedure, names, addresses, positions, and places of employment of the defendants, and no signature on the amended complaint.

In response, Plaintiff moves to voluntarily dismiss his complaint.
