ORDER DISMISSING PETITION

Tony E. Wright seeks relief from personal restraint imposed following the revocation of a drug offender sentencing alternative (DOSA) for committing an offense while serving his community custody term. He claims due process violations led to this revocation.

On March 21, 2016, the Department of Correction released Wright from prison after he served the remaining portion of his DOSA sentence. He is no longer under the Department's jurisdiction. As such, there is no relief this court can afford and this petition is moot. *In re Pers. Restraint of Huffman*, 34 Wn. App. 570, 572, 662 P.2d 408 (1983) (relief through personal restraint petition unavailable because petitioner was no longer


