This matter comes before this Court upon the Report and Recommendation of The Honorable J. Kelley Arnold, United States Magistrate Judge (Dkt. #3). Judge Arnold's reasoning is persuasive. (1) The Court adopts the Report and Recommendation;


(2) Plaintiff's causes of action are DISMISSED as frivolous pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e);
