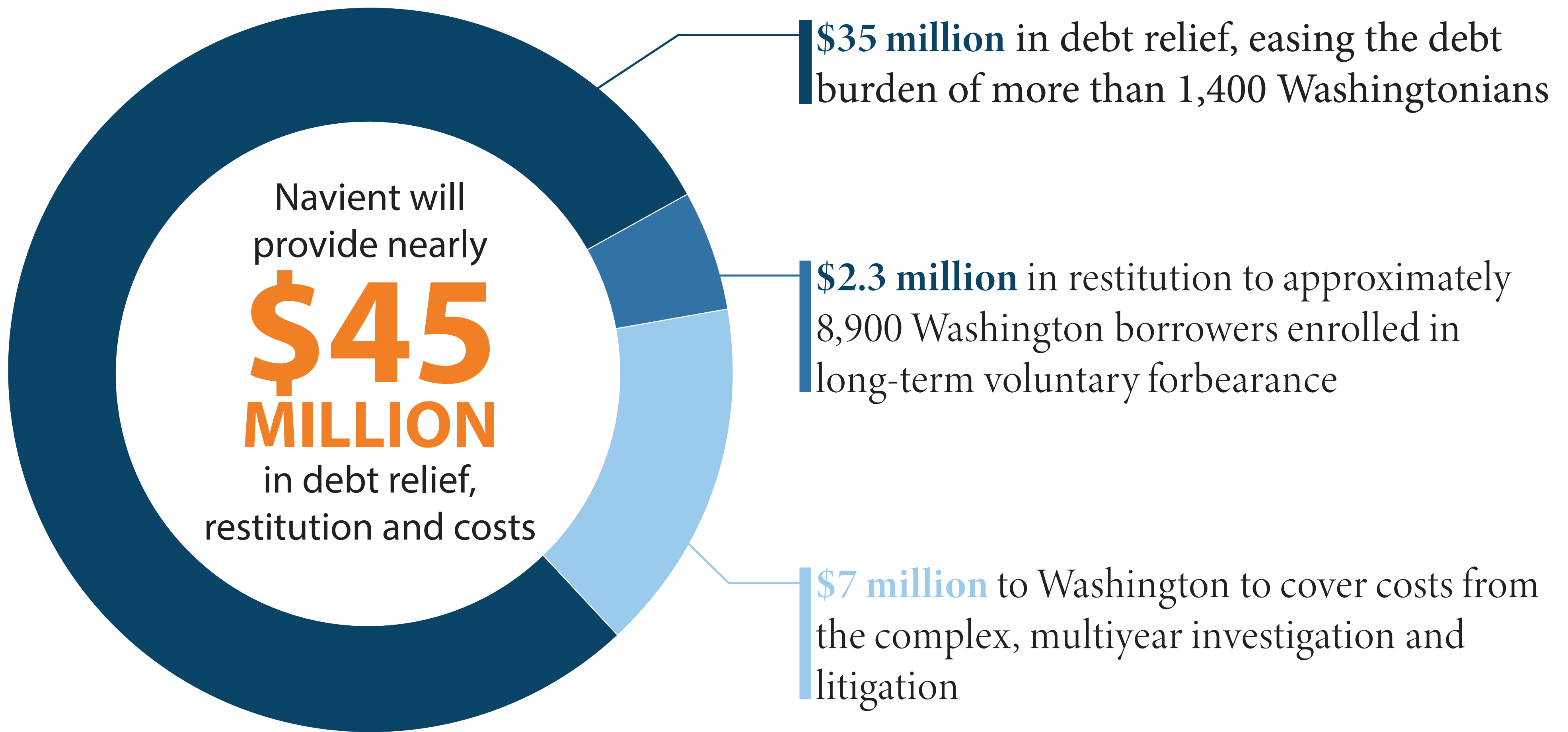


NAVIENT RESOLUTION

Thousands of Washingtonians Will be Eligible to Have Debt Burdens Eased or Receive Other Relief



Who is eligible?

What relief will be offered?

847 Approximately 847 Washingtonians who, from 2002 to 2014, took out subprime private student loans, and had delinquent payments for more than seven consecutive months prior to June 30, 2021.

Any remaining balances on these loans **will be canceled**

717 Approximately 717 Washingtonians who, from 2002 to 2014, took out non-subprime private student loans to attend certain private, for-profit colleges, and who had delinquent payments for more than seven consecutive months prior to June 30, 2021.

Any remaining balances on these loans **will be canceled**

8,900 Approximately 8,900 Washingtonians who contacted Navient due to long-term financial hardships with their non-Parent PLUS federal student loans, and were enrolled into forbearance for an extended period of time.

These student borrowers can expect to **receive a check of around \$260**
